**About Judy Klitsner**

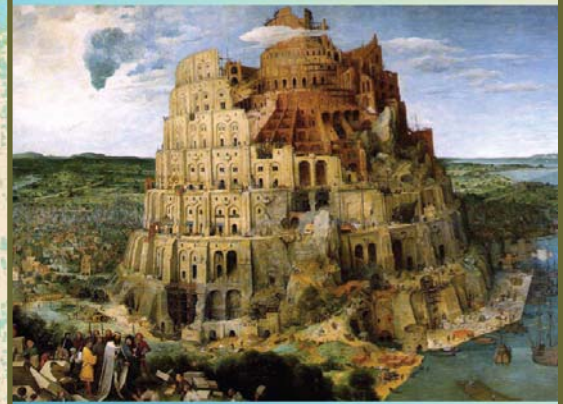
